

## Whatcom County Top Employers: 2020

The Center for Economic and Business Research at Western Washington University asks businesses for permanent full-time employees based in Whatcom County each year – the following table is for employment counts as of 12/31/20. Getting this information is harder than you might think due to differences in how companies define full-time, how to count people who work in different locations during the year, etc. Numbers in the table should be used for discussion purposes and reference, with an understanding of the uncertainty surrounding the numbers.

In conducting this research, we have included those companies reporting a headcount of more than 250 to help limit the overall size of the list.

Due to COVID-19 we asked those responding to the survey for the experience and expectations involving remote work and a return to office environments. While recognizing that this is subject to change based on the course of the pandemic it provides a lens into the potential landscape changes that await the county's workforce. Those companies that manufacture or conduct in-person transactions as a core function were most likely to report near normal working conditions whereas many companies that could offer remote working for positions stated that they were prepared to continue such arrangements into 2021 for an average of 30% of the workforce.

The response rate for the Top Employers report has been especially low this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Top Employers report this year also included some COVID-19 related questions in order to better understand the impact of the pandemic in the businesses in Whatcom county. Our research suggests that most companies still have non-essential personnel working remotely and that their workforce number has been reduced due to the pandemic.

This past year marked a significant change with the announcement regarding Intalco which would have appeared at 11 on this list with an estimated headcount, pre-closure of approximately 720.
