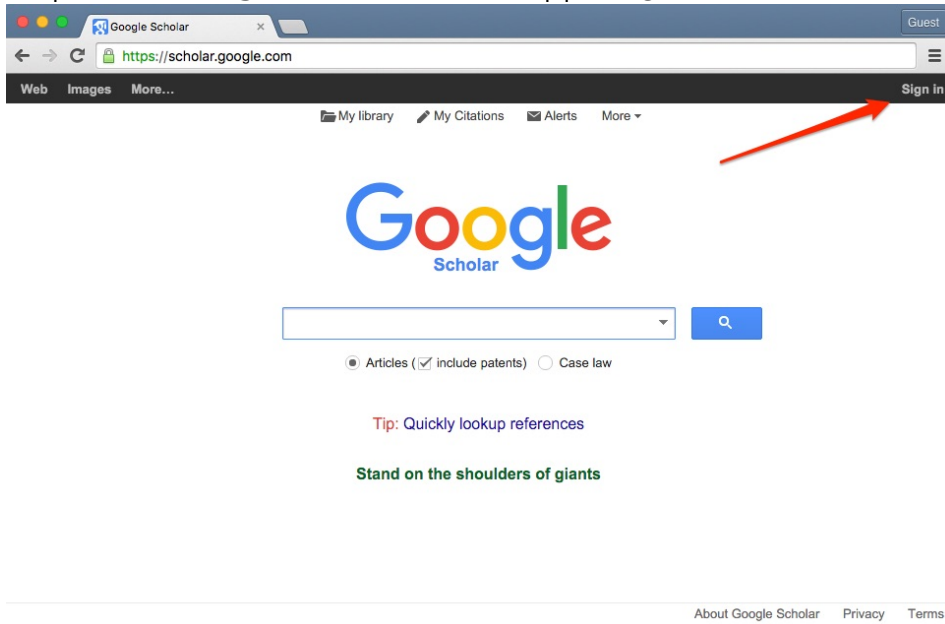


# Create a Google Scholar Account




Step 4 – Fill in relevant information. You're able to use your WWU account information for your Google account which will prevent a new Gmail account from being created.
