<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One Communication Focus (CF) course: <b>OPS 468</b></li> <li>A minimum of three writing proficiency points from approved upper division courses: <b>OPS 464 (WP3)</b></li> <li>A minimum of 90 credits in areas other than accounting &amp; business administration</li> <li>A minimum of 180 total credit hours (a maximum of 105 transferred credits)</li> <li>A minimum of 60 credits must be upper division (300 or 400 level courses)</li> <li>A minimum of 50% of Business Admin. credits must be taken at WWU</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Complete <b>MATH 157, DSCI 205, ACCT 240, and ACCT 245</b> early</li> <li>Admission to MSCM program as a full major requires a minimum GPA of 3.0 in MSCM foundation courses (including Chemistry and Physics)</li> <li>Take <b>OPS 360</b> as soon as possible after completing the prerequisites</li> <li><b>ENGR 104</b> is typically only offered once per year during spring quarter</li> <li><b>MFGE 261</b> only offered once per year during winter quarter</li> <li>Take MGMT 495 in one of your last two quarters, if possible</li> <li>Work with your Faculty Advisor to choose elective courses</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>MIS 220:</b> CBE Pre-majors &amp; majors receive registration priority; CBE restrictions removed when registration reaches 44 cr.</li> <li><b>Core Courses:</b> CBE Pre-majors &amp; majors receive registration priority; CBE restrictions removed when registration reaches 44 credits</li> <li><b>MGMT 313 and MIS 321:</b> MSCM majors can register for MGMT 313 and/or MIS 321 when registration reaches 90 credits</li> <li><b>MGMT 495:</b> Full major &amp; Junior class status required</li> <li><b>OPS 464:</b> Instructor permission required; first-time enrollment restricted to MSCM students with foundation or full-major status; second-time enrollment restricted to MSCM students with full-major status</li> </ul>
